




## QAI impact (4/5): portal stats

White Paper 331 downloads



#### Questions received during the talk


- What is the privacy model (to collect user information) of Quick Apps? Is it the same than in Android?
- Do you have statistics of how much less code you need to develop Quick App?
- " It looks very much like a browser with a unified API. Like Cordova?
- " Is it multi-platform (Android, IOS, Linux, Windows, MacOS, ...)?
- " How does it happen when resources aren't available (photo camera...)?
- " How are permissions managed? A parallel system? Nothing planned (i.e., in practice, bypassing Android / IOS permissions using browser permissions for all these apps)?

These questions confirmed the need for more information and resources about the underlying technology of quick apps, the differences with the current technologies, but also the interest in a new concept based on well-known frameworks.


