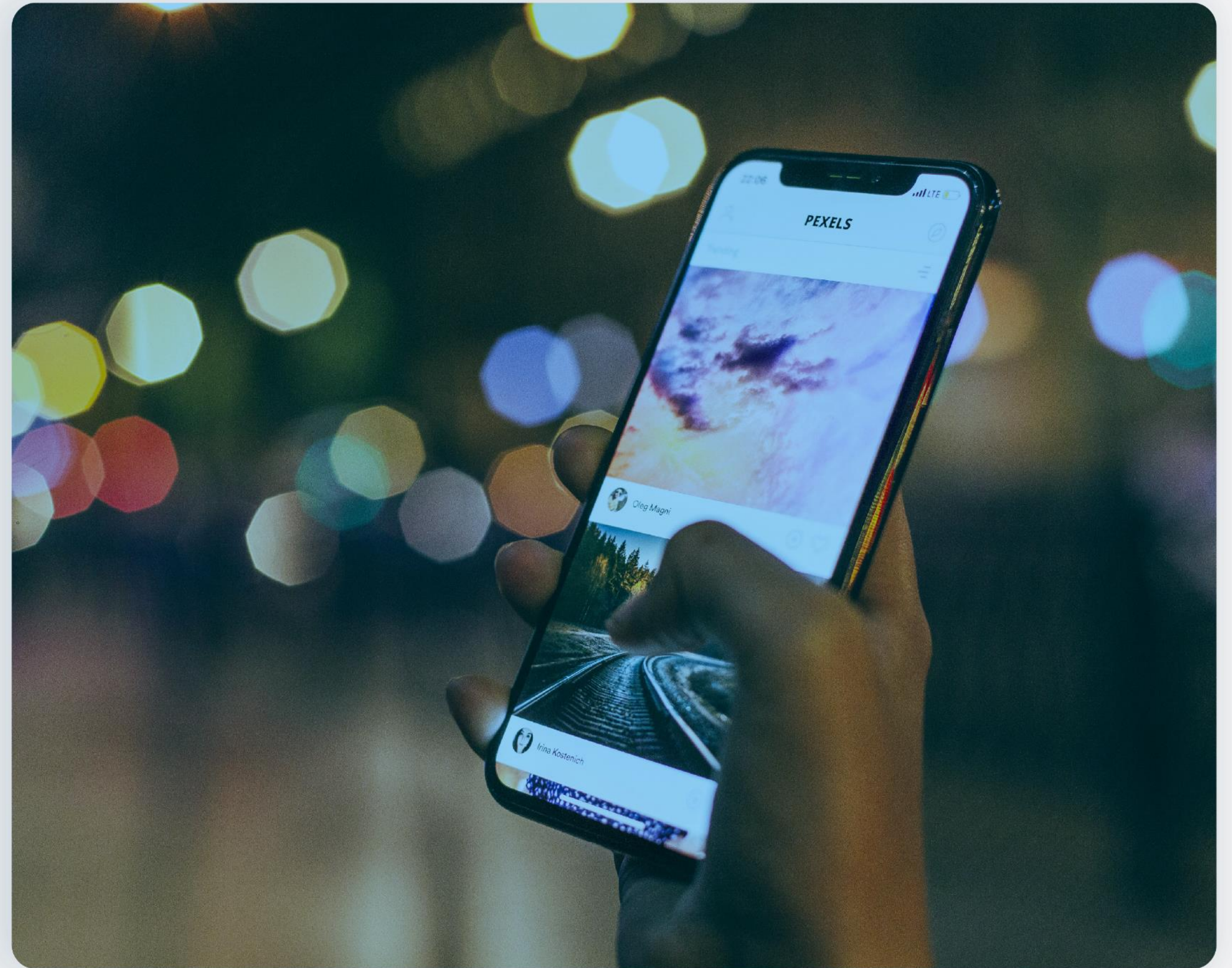
# NEW DEVELOPER SECTION

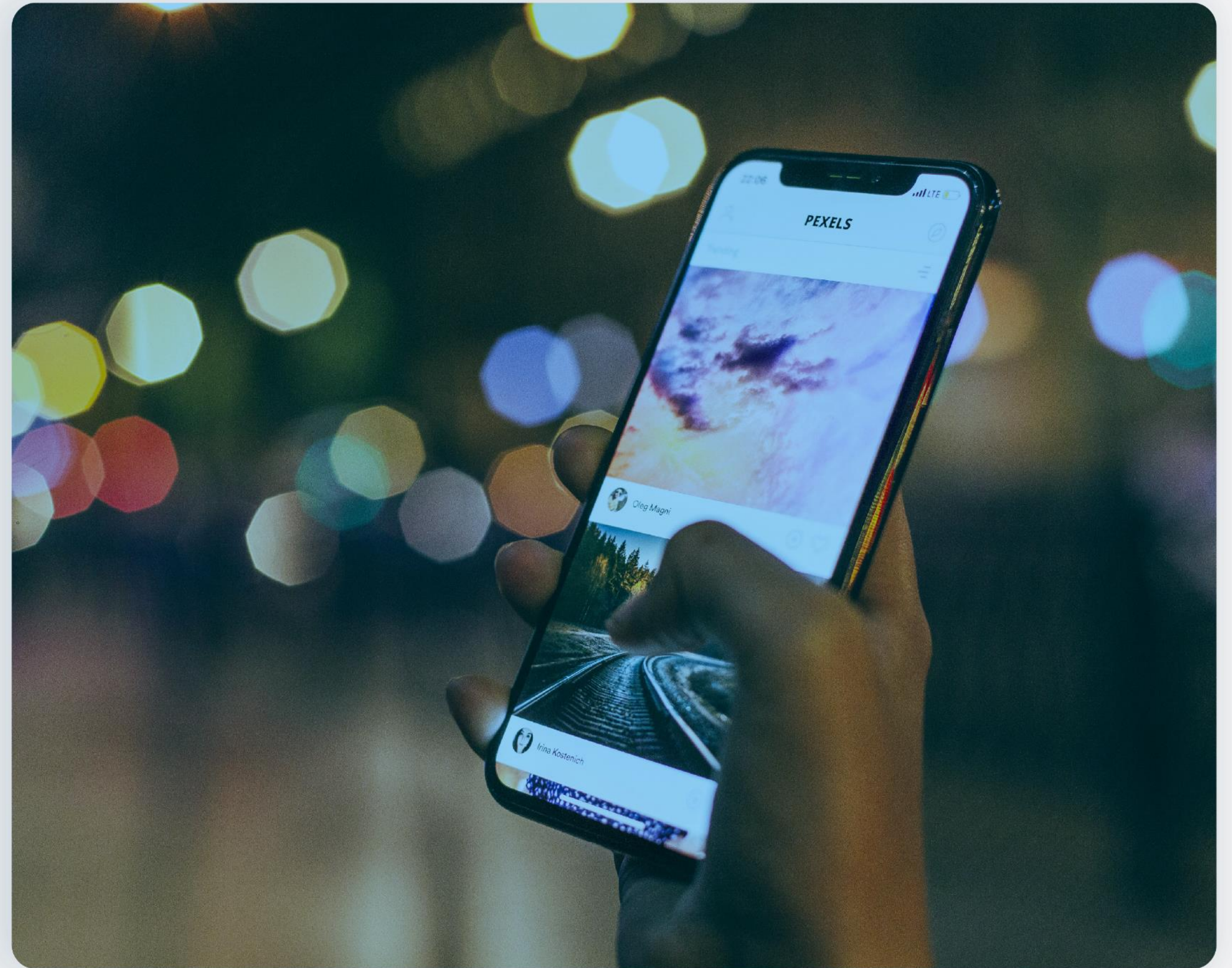

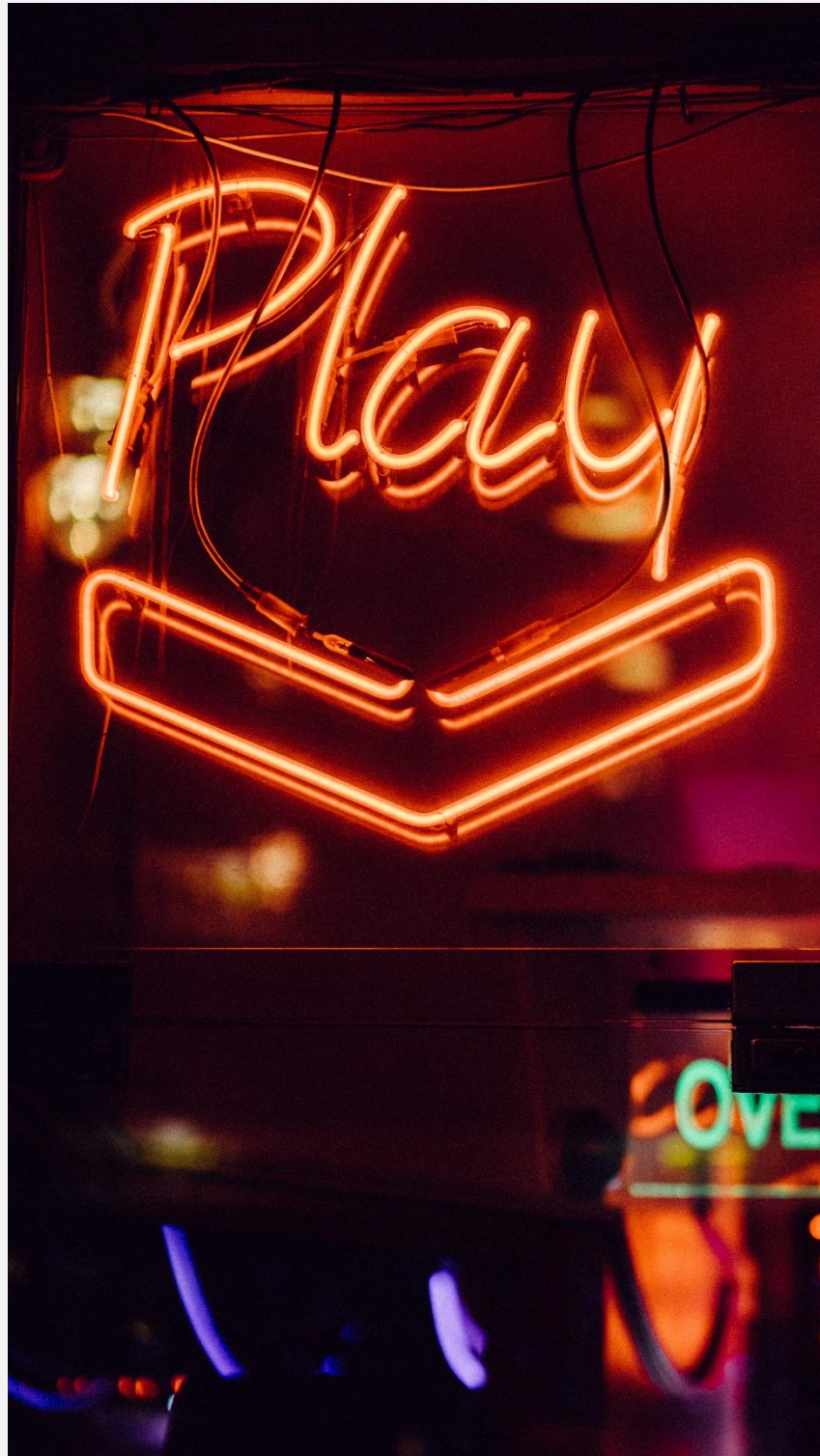

### 1. PRESENTATION OF STARTIN'BLOX

---

#### 1.1. THE TEAM

---

Startin'blox

European leader in the new architectures induced by the standards like Solid, IDS and Gaia-X, Startin'blox helps ecosystems of companies work better together without even having to all use the same tools. We developed an innovative technology, based on Solid and Tim Berners-Lee's vision, the founder of the Web. Our apps are based on ready made modules, easily assembled together to become a fully functional application that our users can then customize as much as they want to fit their business processes.

We are working in many industries, such as freelancing, cooperatives, renewable energy, trade unions, space, employment, film industry, education, hotels and the public sector, and have discussions with potential partners in many others. We have gathered a community of 100 freelancers, developers, ambassadors, investors and early adopters and have deployed more than 50 applications for 20 clients.

### 2.2. PROPOSED USE CASE

We propose to investigate all these subjects by adapting an existing application to the QuickApp platform. We'll do all the necessary adaptations in the process, so that adapting another application based on either our specific framework or following the WebComponents standard will be straightforward.

We propose to use a collaboration application directed to collectives of freelancers with a standard set of features, including a group chat, a directory of profiles, a map and a job board. Adapting all these features should cover enough technical cases, so that we can be confident most standard usages will be covered.

### 2.5. THE ASSISTANCE WE NEED

The assistance we would require is both technical, getting quick knowledge from the current contributors and leaders of the project, and financial, with a cost estimated at around ~90k€ to build a convincing POC, if everything goes well.
