






OW2 **Quick App** Initiative

- The current name today
- "Quick App" term largely unknown in the west

OW2 **MiniApp** Initiative

- Quick Apps + MiniApps
- Name aligns with the W3C
 Working Group scope
- Like "Quick App", the term
 "MiniApp" is also not widely
 known in the west → name
 change should not be an issue

OW2 **Light Apps** Initiative

- Quick Apps + MiniApps + PWAs
- Intrinsically understandable term, even if exact definition is unclear
- ... but do we really want to cover PWAs?

OW2 Web Technologies Initiative

- Quick Apps + MiniApps + PWAs + other
- Very easy to understand
- Allows activity in any web related technology
- ... but maybe too broad?






